### GENERAL RULES AND PARADE DAY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Entries will be closed on **Friday October 12, 2018**
2. California State Horsemen's Assoc. rules apply for mounted entries.
3. All entries will receive a Certificate of Participation.
4. Separate entry forms, together with publicity information, must be submitted.
5. Entries must maintain 25 foot space intervals & always be moving in a forward motion.
6. Bands will play throughout the entire parade route.
7. **FOR SAFETY—NO ITEMS MAY BE THROWN during parade route! Items can be handed to audience at curb side.**
8. Amateur floats must be designed and fully made by amateurs.
9. Color guards must comply with public law pertaining to display of national colors.
10. All motor vehicles must have proof of insurance & a valid license.
11. Motorized vehicles & animals must always be under control.
12. Entries with sound & noise must be indicated on entry form.
13. Entries under six years of age, must be accompanied by an adult.

16. Contestants must complete entire parade route to avoid disqualification.
17. NO ENTRY may enter the parade route more than one time.
18. The Rio Vista Festival or Parade Chairman reserves the right to disqualify or reject any entry.
19. Parade awards will be presented on **Saturday Oct, 13 at 6:00 pm**; announced designated area an hour after parade end.
20. All awards can be claimed Parade day or later at the Chamber office during the following week.
21. All judging decisions are final.
